## What to pack in an emergency kit

- First-Aid kit
- Map
- Flashlight
- Water (one gallon per person per day for several days, for drinking and sanitation)
- Cell phone charger and batteries
- Food (at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food)
- Prescription & Non-prescription medications
- Money and important documents
- Pocket knife and tools
- Whistle (to signal for help)
- Manual can opener
- Matches
- Battery-powered/hand crank radio
  & a NOAA Weather Radio

## Pet Emergency Kit

- Bowl and/or pet food and water
- Medication
- Vaccine records
- A treat/bone
- Shelter/other important contact information
- ID Tag
- Leash
- Toy
- Crate or carrier
